"What is Stewardship?"

Dear Partners in Ministry,

First time visitors to a Lutheran congregation might be confused by some of our unique vocabulary, such as: Kyrie, Gospel, Sanctus, thy, trespasses, benediction, and stewardship. Could you explain each of them to a newcomer?

If not, I'm sorry I'm only going to explain stewardship today...but who knows, maybe I'll explain the others another time. But as we enter the traditional time for a "fall stewardship" drive, let me give you a definition.

Stewardship is the practice of being generous with the time, talent, and "treasure" (financial resources) God provides each of us.

I would add it caring for the earth and using its resources responsibly and as sustainably as possible as well.

Christ Lutheran doesn't have an active Stewardship Team, so I'm not sure if a formal "stewardship campaign" will happen this fall. Hopefully we'll at least get you a pledge card, but for now, let me say this:




